Narrative:
SB 2262 requires snowmobile dealers to register each snowmobile sold and requires all snowmobile operators to wear helmets. The fees collected from registration include a \$2 registration fee and a \$6 snowmobile trails tax for each even-numbered two year period beginning January 1, 1980. The \$2 portion of the registration is deposited by Motor Vehicle. The \$6 portion is deposited by Parks and Recreation into the Snowmobile Trails Tax Fund. This fund is used for the development, operation and maintenance of snowmobile trails in North Dakota.
SB 2262 also requires that fees collected from safety courses be deposited to the Snowmobile Trails Tax Fund. The snowmobile safety training course allows persons twelve to sixteen years of age to legally operate a snowmobile outside the lands owned by the person's parent or guardian.
