Narrative:

This legislation will enable the Department to ensure that asbestos removal contractors and workers within the state are trained, tested, and licensed. The discovery of asbestos as a major health problem in public and school buildings has led to a major environmental effort to remove that asbestos. Removal of the asbestos in an unqualified manner or utilizing improper procedures could result in a greater health hazard than failure to remove existing asbestos.

The Department intends to establish a license fee system for the certification program.
