Narrative:

The State Department of Health currently administers and enforces the provisions of Chapter 23-20.3 concerning hazardous waste in North Dakota. Under the proposed changes, we do not foresee where we would be required to conduct any activities significantly different from those performed under the current law. No significant fiscal effect is expected at the state level.

This measure would provide for more involvement by counties and cities. Projecting a fiscal effect for them is difficult due to the varying degree of involvement they may undertake in the review and permitting process. Actual costs may be significant depending upon staffing and training activities. Costs of a special election for a major city, e.g., Bismarck, are projected to be \$10,000-\$12,000.
