Narrative:

The transfer of the Ag Products Utilization Commission to the North Dakota Agricultural Experiment Station will provide a savings of \$80,660 in personnel costs and \$19,903 in operating costs, thereby reducing the cost of administering this program from \$181,863 to \$81,300 - a reduction of \$100,563. That savings plus an increase of \$52,505 in the recommended budget will increase the money available for research grants by \$153,068.

The consolidation includes a physical move of the Ag Products Utilization staff to Morrill Hall, North Dakota State University, eliminating the need for office space rental.
