In the following space note the fiscal effect in dollars of this
measure: For the purposes of estimating the fiscal impact of this bill, the
Secretary of state's office called seven county registers of deeds. This included counties with large, medium, and small populations. The large counties averaged about 3,300 filings a year, the medium
counties averaged about 1,600 filings a year, and the small counties averaged
about 800 filings a year. Most county register of deeds estaimated between 25 and 30% of the filings were made against growing crops. Using the above
figures as a base, we estaimated 15,100 filings will be made each year in the
secretary of state's office and we will generate \$75,500 each year. Of course,
the counties will lose the same amount of income.
With the additional 15,100 filings made in our office, we would realisticall
need to add one full time employee to cover the expected workload impact.
