	It appears the intent of this bill is to change the source of funding for the Highway Patrol from the state highway fund to a combination of the highway fund and the general fund.
	It is estimated the fee provided in this bill will generate \$1,800,000.00 the first year and \$1,880,000.00 the second year for a total of \$3,680,000.00 for the biennium. The current Highway Patrol budget under consideration provides for \$17,513,716.00 from the state highway fund. The net effect of this bill would be to increase the state highway fund by \$3,680,000.00 and decrease the general fund by \$3,680,000.00.
	It should also be noted that the Motor Vehicle Department anticipates the need for an additional budget enhancement of \$140,000.00 to implement this bill. This budget enhancement will decrease the fiscal effect on the state highway fund to \$3,540,000.00. The budget enhancement is for the following:
