<u>Narrative</u> :
It should be noted that state employees would be receiving 13 pay periods during the calendar year. The payroll system would have to be reprogrammed to accept the supplemental (temporary/overtime) to the advance and the present advanced to the supplemental. This would then reflect on the agencies' accounting reports as to their payables, therefore the accounting system will have to be reprogrammed as to salaries. The total cost of reprogramming is estimated to be \$150,000. This would also cause problems with quarterly reports with IRS and Social Security which we have not received final answers. It is estimated that the state would lose \$120,000 of interest income based on \$14,000,000 monthly payroll due to paying the last working day instead of the first.
