Narrative:

This legislation would eliminate the waiving of charges by the State Auditor for audits of state agencies. During the 1985-1987 biennium approximately \$58,000 in audit fees was waived. For the period July, 1987 through December 1988, there was approximately \$48,000 in audit fees waived. Audit fees charged by the State Auditor are deposited into the state's general fund.
