<u>Narrative</u> : It is difficult to estimate the fiscal impact of this bill. Therefore, examples of impact will be shown.	
1. Very likely, this bill will mean reduced enrollments. For example, if tuition revenues declined 10%, the institutions would experience a \$9 million reduction in 1989-91 estimated tuition revenue.	
2. In 1987-88 there were 4,609 graduates receiving bachelors degrees, graduate degrees, or professional degrees. If, for example, 2/3 left the state and each student were required to pay \$7,000 to \$8,000, approximately \$21 - \$25 million would be owed by the students to be repaid over 10 years.	
3. Additional administrative expenses would be required of the institutions. For example, 6 additional FTE staff at \$15,000 per year plus fringes equals \$225,000 biennially. Also, Section 1, Subsection 5 of the bill requires a program cost accounting system to be developed by the Board of Higher Education. This could cost approximately \$100,000-\$200,000. No estimate is made of Bank of North Dakota administrative expenses.
