Narrative: The amendments to HB 1604 will not change the fiscal impact on the fiscal note dated 2-3-89. That fiscal note was as follows:  HB1604 provides for the addition of one full-time-Equivalent staff position to administer the proposed comprehensive health education program, a ten member health education advisory committee, and grants to local districts to help implement their comprehensive health plan.  The fiscal notes for the staff positions are as follows:  salary and benefits \$70,000  operating expenses 18,300  advisory committee 7,700  grants 704,000  total \$800,000	
The health coalition would add two members (physician and community member) to its membership so that another board will not be created. The additional responsibilities of the board would require the board to conduct five additional meetings per biennium.	
The grants would be distributed to schools based on an allocation process established by the superintendent: \$704,000 per biennium.	₽d
