Narrative:						

Section 1 of HB 1674 is expected to increase State General Fund revenue and decrease State Aid Distribution Fund revenue by approximately -\$900,000 as shown below. This was computed using a 6% tax rate effective May 1, 1989.

The fiscal impact of Sections 2, 3, and 4 of HB 1674 are not included in this fiscal note. These sections suspend the temporary ½% sales tax effective May 1, 1989 to coincide with the effective date of SB 2458, which raises the rate to 6%. The fiscal note on SB 2458 was computed with the assumption that the sales tax rate would increase only $\frac{1}{2}\%$ of 1%for the months of May and June, 1989. Therefore, there is no need to consider the negative fiscal impact of the suspension here.
