The proposed amendments to SB 2251 do not alter the fiscal effect. The original fiscal note stated the following:

Sections 8 and 13 of SB 2251 provide a credit for special fuels and motor fuels taxes paid on accounts later found to be worthless and written off for income tax purposes. The negative fiscal impact of these sections cannot be determined.

All other sections of SB 2251 have a fiscal effect of less than \$5,000 during the 1989-91 biennium.
