Narrative:

As amended, SB 2254 provides that the state contribution will not be reduced for the current authorized part-time permanent state employees for whom the state is contributing the entire state portion of the health insurance premium. There is no fiscal impact for the 1989-91 biennium.

HOWEVER, SINCE THE EXECUTIVE BUDGET REFLECTED THE FISCAL IMPACT OF REDUCING THE STATE CONTRIBUTION FOR HEALTH INSURANCE BASED ON THE FULL-TIME EQUIVALENCY OF CURRENT AUTHORIZED EMPLOYEE POSITIONS, A TOTAL OF \$615,852, OF WHICH \$281,946 IS FROM THE GENERAL FUND, AND \$333,906 IS IN SPECIAL FUNDS, WILL NEED TO BE ADDED TO AGENCY BUDGETS.
