Narrative: Estimated tuition collections under SB2460 for the 1989-91
biennium are \$96.17 to \$98.84 million. This is \$20.09 to \$22.76 million more than 1987-89 estimated tuition for the 11 campuses. It is \$9 to \$12 million more than the Executive Enhanced Budget. The Executive Enhanced budget requires \$11.7 million more from tuition collections than 1987-89 collections. See the attached schedules for a further analysis of the estimated revenue and the impact on tuition rates.
If $2/3$ of the resident students received loans, approximately \$10-11 million would be loaned during the biennium. If $\frac{1}{2}$ of residents received loans, approximately \$8 million would be loaned during the biennium. This fiscal note does not include an estimate of Bank of North Dakota expenses to develop and administer the loan program.
