## Narrative:

This bill reimburses the Attorney General for attorney fees, costs and expenses incurred in bringing legal action under the state's consumer fraud law. This bill enables the Attorney General's Consumer Fraud Section to deposit fees collected into the Attorney General Consumer Protection Fund to pay costs incurred in the operation of the Attorney General's Consumer This will result in approximately \$15,000 per Fraud Section. biemmium additional funding for the Consumer Fraud Section.

Also, the bill enables the Attorney General's Office to charge and collect, in advance, fees to defray the actual costs of background investigations of certain applicants who apply for a gaming work permit, applicants who apply for a distributors license, and applicants who apply for a manufacturers license to sell charitable gaming tickets or paper bingo cards in North Dakota. The amount collected is placed in the attorney general's refund fund. When an investigation is conducted, any amount collected in excess of the actual costs is refunded to the applicant. This provision will have no fiscal impact.
