## Narrative:

HB 1200, if enacted, would increase the tax rate on 27,596 acres of present woodland tax land from \$.40 per acre to \$.50 per acre, and the qualifications would be relaxed to allow more wooded acres to be taxed at the flat \$.50 per acre rate. Because of the Centennial Tree Project and the potential of adding other forested areas to the forest stewardship tax, the enactment of HB 1200 has a fiscal effect of reducing revenue to the state medical center ranging from-\$2,800 to-\$5,800 for the 1991-93 biennium, reducing property tax revenue to the county from -\$235,000 to-\$472,000 for the 1991-93 biennium, and reducing property tax revenue to the city less than \$5,000 for the 1991-93 biennium.
