Narrative:
HB 1387, if enacted, would decrease the State General Fund and special funds by less than -\$5,000 and decrease the county and city property tax revenues by less than -\$5,000 during the 1991-93 biennium. However, there are currently 14 agricultural processing facilities receiving a property tax exemption that amounts to approximately \$154,000 per year. If HB 1387 is enacted, these property tax exemptions could be extended for five additional years in future bienniums.
Assumptions:
(1) "Extended" means that the exemption is continuous, once it has expired it cannot be reinstated by virtue of the passage of HB 1387.
