Section 2: 65-05-08, item 1. Eliminating compensation for the first 5 days of disability would produce a savings to the fund of \$600,000 per year or \$1,200,000 per biennium.

Section 2: 65-05-08, item 5. The amount saved under a one year limit on retroactive payments would be approximately \$90,000 per year of \$180,000 per biennium based on 1990 activity.

Section 5: 65-05-09.2, item 1 and 2. Total incremental savings from this change in the retirement offset would be about \$350,000. This represents savings generated over the life of claimants reaching retirement age during the 1991-93 biennium. Implementation of this bill would reduce payments during the 1991-93 biennium by about 33,000.

Section 7: 65-05-10, item 7. Limit Partial Disability: Savings are estimated to be approximately \$50,000 annually or \$100,000 per biennium.

Section 11: 65-05-35. Estimated annual savings attributable to claims abandonment is \$679,000 or \$1,358,000 per biennium.

Section 12: 65-06.2-02, item 1. Confined Claimants: Total benefits paid to these claimants in FYE 1990 was approximately \$29,000. Estimated future savings are approximately \$58,000 per biennium.

Other sections of this proposal will also produce savings of varying amounts. These amounts have not been determined and are not included in the totals above.
