Senate Bill No. 2338, will amend 49-18-41 and in part delete the portion of the statute that requires the Public Service Commission to issue an identification plate and tab to each motor vehicle (except bus & taxi) operating under the jurisdiction of the Commission. The present identification would be replaced by revising the present identification card (certificate) that is issued to each vehicle.

The fee for the plate is presently \$20.00 per plate, to include the current year tab. The proposed amendment authorizes the Commission to collect \$20.00 for the issue of the identification card (certificate).

There would be no loss in revenues to the state if the amendment passes. In fact, there will be a savings as the Department of Transportation, Motor Vehicle Services Division furnishes the plate and tab presently at a cost of \$3.00 per plate and \$.07 per tab.

The Commission will require 5,000 plates and tabs for the '91-'92 year, which cost amounts to \$15,210 and for the years '92-'93 the Commission will require approximately 3,000 tabs at a cost of \$210. The Commission must update its computer program to allow for issuing the new cab card (certificate) at a one time cost of \$7,500. The total effect for the '91-'92 year will be a savings to the state of \$7,710, and the effect for '92-'93 year will be a savings of \$210.
