In the following space note the fiscal effect in dollars of this measure:

Narrative:

This bill increases the monthly rent allowance that licensed gaming organizations may pay lessors (owners) of authorized gaming sites. The monthly rent allowance for each twenty-one table would increase, from the present \$150 maximum, to \$250 maximum. Also, the monthly rent allowance for conducting charitable gaming tickets when bingo is not the primary game would change as follows:

1. If twenty-one is also conducted, the additional monthly rent increases, from the present \$50 maximum, to \$200 maximum.
2. If twenty-one is not conducted, the monthly rent increases, from the present \$150 maximum, to \$300 maximum.

Since rent expense does not affect adjusted gross proceeds (gross proceeds less prizes) which is the basis on which the gaming tax is computed, there is no fiscal effect to the general fund.
