<u>Narrative</u> : The total insurance premium tax collected for the five lines of insurance affected by the insurance premium tax distribution payments in the 1991-93 biennium is \$6,266,261. Of that total, \$5,200,000 is appropriated to the special fund for payment to the city fire departments, rural fire protection districts, and rural fire departments, resulting in a net income to the general fund of \$1,066,261. By removing the "cap" and basing the fire district payments on 84% of the premium tax collected, with the remaining 16% to the general fund, the impact to the general fund is \$62,700 for the 1993-95 biennium. 2. <u>State</u> fiscal effect in dollar amounts:
