Presently, if a class B organization's quarterly adjusted gross proceeds (gross proceeds less prizes) exceeds \$60,000, the organization does not qualify. This bill will increase the quarterly adjusted gross proceeds limitation to \$100,000. Also, this bill will enable several class B organizations, which now qualify, to continue to qualify and retain their gaming sites. The amendment declares the act to be an emergency measure.
