1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, and cities.

Narrative:

The Division of Parole/Probation is currently seeing an increase in Presentence Investigations (PSI) being ordered. In reviewing the 91-92 sex offense cases opened by the Division, I project we would be required to conduct 163 mandatory PSI's during the 93-95 biennium. I would project a total of 647 PSI investigation reports ordered during 93-95 biennium. We anticipate contracting 467 PSI's to private providers at \$100 per PSI. The remaining PSI's would be completed by existing staff. We would project an increase of 25 PSI's in 95-97.
