Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, and cities.

Narrative: The Office of the Attorney General currently has neither the personnel nor the technical expertise in the health care industry necessary to carry out the duties imposed on the office by SB 2295. When a somewhat similar bill was enacted in Maine, an additional 1/2 FTE was authorized and funded for the Attorney General and another 1/2 FTE for the Health Dept. I have used Maine's experience as a basis for my estimates. Because, unlike Maine which split the duties between the Attorney General and the Health

Dept., this bill assigns all of the duties to the Atorney General, the estimates assume one additional FTE for the Attorney General. Because of the State fiscal effect in dollar amounts: complex nature of the duties, this FTE 2.
