Narrative: The potential fiscal impact on SB 2344 would not occur until the 95-97 biennium. The bill involves payments to potential member districts in restructuring consortiums whose average daily membership exceeds 1000. The payment to these districts would b based on the average daily membership of consortium districts in that consortium whose average daily membership is less than 1000. Since no consortiums have been formed which include districts with average daily memberships of over 1000 and since it is virtually impossible to estimate how many smaller districts would come together with those districts in a consortium, it is subsequently nearly impossible to estimate a fiscal impact. Given those limitations the best available estimate is that the cost in the 95-97 biennium need \$225,000.
