	This fiscal note is based on criminal misdemeanor dispositions reported in the 1991 Annual ND Judicial System report. During 1991, the ND county courts disposed of 21,240 misdemeanor cases and the 10 largest municipal courts disposed of 3,107 misdemeanor cases. Of these cases, 10,800 were traffic cases which have been excluded per the amendments to SB 2378. It is assumed that a \$25 surcharge is assessed in every case. It also assumes that 25% of the cases involve multiple offenses for a single offender, therefore, reducing the total of potential offenders to 10,160 a year. We expect a 4% increase in offenders during 95-97.
