User Services and Costs

The North Dakota Natural Heritage Program Inventory (NDNHP) database maintains the most complete single source of existing data on North Dakota's rare plants and animals in North Dakota, including federally listed and candidate species, sensitive species and high-priority natural communities.

The format of the database follows a standard nationwide methodology used by The Nature Conservancy's network of natural heritage programs. Information from these databases is available to the public through data requests to North Dakota Parks and Recreation Department's Natural Heritage Program.

While this information is available for preparation and review of environmental documents, please note that the data are dependent on the research and observations of many individuals and organizations, and in most cases are not the result of comprehensive or site-specific field surveys. Natural Heritage information should never be regarded as final statements on the occurrence of rare species, communities or areas being considered, nor should they be substituted for on-site surveys. Also, because the NDNHP database is continually updated and because data requests are evaluated by type of action, any given response is only wholly appropriate for its respective request.

Data requests require written application either on the attached form or by a letter including the same information. When citing the data provided, crediting NDNHP is requested.

Fees are charged for providing the data. Service include data retrieval, data analysis, manual searches, preparation of reports and maps, and packaging completed requests. The following rates apply:

COMPUTER/MANUAL SEARCHES AND ANALYSIS:

A fee of \$40 per search is standard.

Normal turn-around time for handling most requests in 5 working days from the receipt of the request.

MATERIALS, SHIPPING, MISCELLANEOUS CHARGES:

Regular costs for printing, photocopying, shipping, and supplies will be charged when in excess of \$5.00. Overnight and express mail will be charged at face value.

BIOLOGICAL FIELD SURVEYS:

\$150.00 per day for field work. Travel expenses at standard state rates will apply.
