BILL NO. Amendment to HB 1208; Draft 58249.0204

SUMMARY OF ACTUARIAL INFORMATION: The Workers Compensation Bureau, together with its Actuary, Glenn Evans of Pacific Actuarial Consultants, have reviewed the legislation proposed in this bill in conformance with Section 54-03-25 of the North Dakota Century Code.

While the impact to the amount of attorney fees that the Fund pays may be material, the overall impact of this change will be nominal. As a result, the Actuary predicts no significant change to the rate or reserve levels as the result of this change.

The amendment will not change the impact as described above.
