This bill removes the deducts that occur when a school district does not meet accreditation standards. It also establishes weighting factors and per pupil payments for the 1995-97 biennium. The elimination of the accreditation deducts has no fiscal impact, since no school district has ever lost funds as a result of this language. This year, 3 elementary schools were deducted for non-accreditation, but we anticipate that these funds will be reinstated prior to the end of the year because the districts will meet accreditation standards. The weighting factor and per pupil changes allow for a reduction in the foundation aid line item of \$2,831,026. These changes would result in a reduction in payments from the 1994-95 fiscal year.
