BILL NO. HB 1219

SUMMARY OF ACTUARIAL INFORMATION: The Workers Compensation Bureau, together with its Actuary, Glenn Evans of Pacific Actuarial Consultants, have reviewed the legislation proposed in this bill in conformance with Section 54-03-25 of the North Dakota Century Code.

The changes proposed in this bill relate to the procedures of the Fund in applying funds recovered from third parties. The actuary has determined that this change will not have an impact on Workers Compensation rates or benefits. Further, it is not anticipated that the Fund will incur any significant cost in making the procedural changes required.
