## ND WORKERS COMPENSATION BUREAU 1995 LEGISLATION SUMMARY OF ACTUARIAL INFORMATION

**BILL DESCRIPTION:** 

Repeal of the Exemption of Workers Compensation Hearing

Officers from the Office of Administration Hearings

BILL NO. HB 1287

**SUMMARY OF ACTUARIAL INFORMATION:** The Workers Compensation Bureau, together with its Actuary, Glenn Evans of Pacific Actuarial Consultants, have reviewed the legislation proposed in this bill in conformance with Section 54-03-25 of the North Dakota Century Code.

The Workers Compensation Bureau and its actuary do not expect any actuarial impact as a result of the changes proposed in this bill. There will, however, be a fiscal impact to the operation of the Fund. Currently, the Fund employs two full-time hearing officers supported by two full-time support staff. Including incidentals and travel costs, it is estimated that the total cost to provide these services is approximately \$300,000. Two full-time hearing officers at the Office of Administrative Hearings, at \$50.25 per hour billing rate, would generate operating fees of approximately \$420,000. Based on this analysis, it is estimated that the additional cost to the Workers Compensation Fund would be approximately \$120,000 per year.
