Repeal of the Exemption of Workers Compensation Hearing

BILL NO. Amendment to HB 1287; Draft 50370.0101

**SUMMARY OF ACTUARIAL INFORMATION:** The Workers Compensation Bureau, together with its Actuary, Glenn Evans of Pacific Actuarial Consultants, have reviewed the legislation proposed in this bill in conformance with Section 54-03-25 of the North Dakota Century Code.

The Workers Compensation Bureau and its actuary do not anticipate any actuarial impact as a result of the changes proposed in this bill. There will, however, be a fiscal impact to the operation of the Fund. It is expected that the Administrative cost of implementing this change will include approximately \$10,000 in one-time costs and \$5,000 - \$20,000 annually to fund the salaries, operating and miscellaneous expenses of the remote location.
