The following components would be included as cost items in a statewide high school graduation testing program. There are approximately 8900 high school graduates each year. In addition a number of other students from freshman, sophomore and junior high school levels would be eligible to take the test. As many as 12,000 students a year, may in fact, qualify to take the test. For the biennium 24,000 students would be tested at an estimated \$10 per student for a total cost of \$240,000. One fulltime FTE at the assistant director level would be required to supervise the testing process statewide.
