Spousal Benefits - Death of a Partner

BILL NO. HB 1420

SUMMARY OF ACTUARIAL INFORMATION: The Workers Compensation Bureau, together with its Actuary, Glenn Evans of Pacific Actuarial Consultants, have reviewed the legislation proposed in this bill in conformance with Section 54-03-25 of the North Dakota Century Code.

Based on a review by the Workers Compensation Fund and its actuary, preliminary estimates indicate that the changes proposed in this bill will have a negligible impact on the rate and reserve levels of the Fund. The minimal impact of this change is based on the relatively small number of death claims, a smaller subset who are subject to the two-year settlement upon remarriage, and an even smaller subset subject to death or annulment ending the subsequent marriage.
