The North Dakota University System operates 902 licensed vehicles with a depreciated value of \$6.725 million. It costs approximately \$4.5 million per biennium for motor pool operations. This includes operating expenses for such things as fuel, oil, insurance, tires and funds spent on vehicle replacement.

The fiscal note prepared by State Fleet Services anticipates revenue of \$17.1 million per biennium from the University System. Based upon this estimate and the number of miles driven per year, the charge would be an average rate of \$1.22 per mile. The NDUS does not have the funding available in operating budgets to cover this reimbursement rate to State Fleet.
