BILL DESCRIPTION: Presumption Clause

BILL NO. Engrossed SB 2085 (As amended by 50349.0203)

SUMMARY OF ACTUARIAL INFORMATION: The Workers Compensation Bureau, together with its Actuary, Glenn Evans of Pacific Actuarial Consultants, have reviewed the legislation proposed in this bill in conformance with Section 54-03-25 of the North Dakota Century Code.

It is projected that the actuarial impact associated with the changes proposed in this bill will result in no change to the current loss reserves of the Fund. The proposed change will have some impact on the future losses recorded to the Fund under Rate Class 7720 - Law Enforcement; Rate Class 9415 - Cities; Rate Class 9420 - Counties. This impact, however, will not be material for the near term (2 years). No estimate of impact to rate levels is made for periods beyond that.
