Currently, the \$10 filing fee is charged for each abstract a company is required to have published in each of the seven fire districts in which the company has an insurance agent. Some companies pay a minimum total fee of \$10 while others pay the maximum of \$70.

If Senate Bill No. 2162 is enacted, each company will be assessed a flat fee of \$30. Therefore, some companies would pay less than under the current system and some will pay more.

For example, in 1993 numbers:

There were a total of 3,732 abstracts published for a total cost of \$37,320 to the companies. If instead the approximately 1,350 insurance companies had been charged a flat \$30 filing fee, the total cost would have been \$40,500, an increase of \$3,180. This is an average increased cost of \$2.36 per company.
