In the past 16 years, there have been 37 inmates sentenced to the North Dakota State Penitentiary for a AA felony. Of these 37, 18 still have life sentences. The remainder have "years" sentences, ranging from 15 years to 98 years. We can estimate an average of five people convicted of AA felonies each biennium.

There may be an additional cost for prosecuting AA felons if there is a chance there will be a sentence of life without parole, but it is not possible to attach a dollar figure to this.
