SUMMARY OF ACTUARIAL INFORMATION: The Workers Compensation Bureau, together with its Actuary, Glenn Evans of Pacific Actuarial Consultants, have reviewed the legislation proposed in this bill in conformance with Section 54-03-25 of the North Dakota Century Code.

Based on the review by the Workers Compensation Bureau and its Actuary, the changes addressed in this bill will have an impact in specific cases. The Actuary has indicated that while this is true, it is not anticipated that the change will have a material impact on the current loss reserves or future rate levels of the fund.
