Bismarck, December 3, 1996

At 9:00 a.m., December 3, 1996, according to the Constitution and Statutes of the State of North Dakota, the members elect of the House of Representatives of the Fifty-fifth Legislative Assembly assembled in the House Chamber of the State Capitol at Bismarck, North Dakota, and were called to order by the Speaker of the 1995 Legislative Assembly, Rep. Clarence Martin.

The prayer was offered by Father Daniel Maloney, University of Mary, Bismarck.

ANNOUNCEMENT

SPEAKER MARTIN ANNOUNCED that the House would be on the Fourth order of business:

**COMMUNICATION FROM SECRETARY OF STATE ALVIN A. JAEGER
December 2, 1996**

According to the provisions of N.D.C.C. 54-03-03, the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives, at the opening of each organizational session, shall make a correct roll of the members of the House to whom Certificates of Election have been issued by the proper officers.

As provided for in N.D.C.C. 16.1-15-45, Certificates of Election are prepared by the Secretary of State and then signed by the Secretary of State, the Governor, and a member of the State Canvassing Board. Along with preparing Certificates of Election for statewide elected officials, N.D.C.C. 16.1-15-46 also instructs the Secretary of State to issue Certificates of Election to all members of the Legislative Assembly.

Therefore, in accordance with the above stated sections of law, this letter certifies the attached list of Representatives as being duly elected. A copy of their Certificates of Election will be forwarded within the next few days. These legislators were certified on November 20, 1996 by the State Canvassing Board as being duly elected to their position in the General Election held on November 5, 1996. The legislators from Legislative District 11 were certified on December 2 due to the recount which was demanded and conducted on November 27, 1996.

Each legislator certified as being duly elected has been mailed an Oath of Office to be executed by each legislator as required by Article IV, Section 7 and Article XI, Section 4, of the North Dakota Constitution. Once the oath has been executed, legislators have been instructed to file them with this office.

KRETSCHMAR MOVED that the House adopt as temporary rules the House and Joint Rules of the Fifty-fourth Legislative Assembly as adopted on Thursday, December 8, 1994, and published in the 1995 Senate and House Rules and Committees book, with the exception of House Rule 501(5)(f), which motion prevailed.

REP. CARLSON MOVED that the House amend subsection 1 of temporary House Rule 501 as follows, which motion prevailed:

Overstrike "Standing" and insert immediately thereafter "The Majority Leader shall appoint a Committee on Committees consisting of eight members. Five members must be from the majority party and three members must be from the minority party. The Majority Leader, by virtue of office, is a member of the committee and shall serve as its chairman. The committee shall appoint standing" and overstrike "must be appointed as provided in this section"

REP. R. KELSCH MOVED that the House amend subdivision g of subsection 5 of temporary House Rule 501 as follows, which motion prevailed:

Overstrike "nine" and insert immediately thereafter "seven"
