1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 64-02-10 of the North Dakota Century Code,
2 relating to fees collected by the public service commission for testing or calibrating weighing
3 and measuring devices.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 64-02-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is
6 amended and reenacted as follows:

7 **64-02-10. Fees to test or calibrate weighing and measuring devices.** The
8 commission shall collect the following fees to:

22		When a rejected weighing or measuring device has been reconditioned or replaced by	
23		new equipment, it must be retested and certified before being put into use except as otherwise	
24		provided by rule. The fee for retest and certification is the same as for the first test and	
25		certification.	
26		When a test of a weighing or measuring device is required in addition to the regularly	
27		scheduled annual test, <u>a the commission shall charge of sixty cents per mile [1.61 kilometers]</u>	
28		will be made unless a fee equal to the cost of operating the motor vehicle, including the testing	
29		equipment necessary to perform the test weighs less than ten thousand pounds [4535.92	
30		kilograms] gross. If the motor vehicle weighs less than ten thousand pounds [4535.92	
31		kilograms] gross, a charge of thirty five cents per mile [1.61 kilometers] will be made, and all	

1 used in conducting the test. The mileage charges are, as determined by the commission, must
2 be in addition to the regular test fee and calculated to cover the costs of the additional travel.
3 Where a test has been requested and the person requesting it fails to appear or to have the
4 weighing or measuring device ready for testing at the arranged time, there is a charge of nine
5 dollars a quarter hour for the time between the arranged time and the time at which the test can
6 begin.
