## HOUSE BILL NO. 1296

1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 54-03-01.5 of the North Dakota Century Code,  
2 relating to legislative redistricting requirements.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 54-03-01.5 of the 1995 Supplement to the North  
5 Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **54-03-01.5. Legislative ~~apportionment~~ redistricting requirements.** A legislative  
7 ~~apportionment~~ redistricting plan based on any census taken after ~~1989~~ 1999 must meet the  
8 following requirements:

- 9 1. The senate must consist of forty-nine members and the house must consist of  
10 ninety-eight members.
- 11 2. Except as provided in subsection 3, one senator and two representatives must be  
12 apportioned to each senatorial district. Representatives may be elected at large or  
13 from subdistricts, except representatives must be elected from subdistricts in  
14 districts having a geographical area of three thousand square miles or more.
- 15 3. Multimember senate districts providing for two senators and four representatives  
16 are authorized only when a proposed single member senatorial district includes a  
17 federal facility or federal installation, containing over two-thirds of the population of  
18 the proposed single member senatorial district.
- 19 4. Legislative districts and subdistricts must be compact and of contiguous territory.
- 20 5. Legislative districts must be as nearly equal in population as is practicable.  
21 Population deviation from district to district and subdistrict to subdistrict must be  
22 kept at a minimum. The total population variance of all districts, ~~and subdistricts if~~  
23 ~~created~~, from the average district population and average subdistrict population  
24 may not exceed recognized constitutional limitations.
