- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 34-14-02 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the direct deposit of wages by employers.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 34-14-02 of the 1995 Supplement to the North
 Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 34-14-02. Agreed payday Direct deposit. Every employer shall pay all wages due to employees at least once each calendar month on regular agreed paydays designated in advance by the employer, in lawful money of the United States or with checks on banks
- 9 financial institutions convenient to the place of employment. If an employee participates in a
- 10 direct deposit program, that employee's employer shall deposit the employee's wages into the
- 11 financial institution of the employee's choice. An employer may not require an employee to
- 12 directly deposit the employee's wages into a financial institution of the employee's choosing
- which accepts direct deposits. An employer may not impose a fee on an employee for the
- 14 <u>direct deposit of wages</u>.
