Public Service Commission Fiscal Note Supplement HB 1067

1. Narrative: The legislation continues deregulation proposed telecommunications in North Dakota and implements the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 which opens telephone local exchanges to competition. Under the Federal Act the Public Service Commission must resolve disputes between local exchange companies and competing local service providers. Service Commission anticipates the need for at least one additional utility analyst to assist in handling the additional tasks involved in the transition to a competitive industry and to handle additional duties resulting from the restructuring and deregulation of the electric and gas industries. The funding for one additional staff is included in the Governor's proposed budget (HB1008). This bill also allows the Public Service Commission to establish a state universal service fund which, if established, will require significant additional Commission and staff time.
