Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, cities, and school districts.							
Narrative: House Bill 1070, if enacted, will make permanent the temporary 1995 legislation that provided for special treatment of revenues from irrigated cropland included in the calculation of agricultural land values. Expiration of the temporary legislation will cause agricultural land values to increase beginning with the 1998 tax year.							
The increase in the average agricultural land value should have no effect on property tax revenues to the political subdivisions because current law allows a levy in dollars up to an amount equal to the amount levied in the base year.							
Beginning with the 1997-99 biennium, the one mill state medical center levy will decrease because it is a fixed levy at one mill. The decrease is expected to be less than \$5,000 for any biennium.
