Currently, 20 percent of the oil extraction tax is deposited in the resources trust fund, but the amount would be reduced to 10 percent effective July 1, 1997. Engrossed HB 1071 would keep the amount deposited at 20 percent, and adds \$2 million from the general fund for water projects. The Commission's appropriation bill (HB 1025) includes the 20 percent, but it does not include the additional \$2 million from the general fund.
