BILL DESCRIPTION: Permanent Partial Impairment Definition

BILL NO: HB 1260

SUMMARY OF ACTUARIAL INFORMATION: The Workers Compensation Bureau, together with its Actuary, Glenn Evans of Pacific Actuarial Consultants, have reviewed the legislation proposed in this bill in conformance with Section 54-03-25 of the North Dakota Century Code.

Removes the limitation that disfigurement must diminish ability of the employee to obtain employment to qualify for a PPI award subject to minimum whole body threshold.

ISCAL IMPACT: Not quantifiable. Will increase costs associated with PPI awards for those suffering disfigurement and meeting the minimum whole body threshold. No significant impact anticipated.
