BILL DESCRIPTION: Vocational Rehabilitation

BILL NO: HB 1262

SUMMARY OF ACTUARIAL INFORMATION: The Workers Compensation Bureau, together with its Actuary, Glenn Evans of Pacific Actuarial Consultants, have reviewed the legislation proposed in this bill in conformance with Section 54-03-25 of the North Dakota Century Code.

Streamlines the statutes to remove conflicting provisions and redundancies. Provides for Vocational Consultant's Report due within sixty to ninety days of vocational assessment rather than within sixty to ninety days of initial referral.

FISCAL IMPACT: No impact anticipted.
