BILL DESCRIPTION: Attorney Fee Disputes
BILL NO: HB 1268
SUMMARY OF ACTUARIAL INFORMATION: The Workers Compensation Bureau, together with its Actuary, Glenn Evans of Pacific Actuarial Consultants, has reviewed the legislation proposed in this bill in conformance with Section 54-03-25 of the North Dakota Century Code.
Specifically prohibits a hearing officer or the courts from awarding attorney fees which exceed the maximum amount set by law. Clarifies what conditions are necessary before attorney fees are paid.
FISCAL IMPACT: Not quantifiable. Minimal savings expected.
AMENDMENT: The proposed amendment allows the attorney general to revoke the appointment of a special assistant attorney general only for good cause and defines good cause.
No anticipated impact.
