BILL DESCRIPTION:	Initial Decision,	Process and	Procedure,	and Worker's	Adviser Program

**BILL NO: HB 1270** 

**SUMMARY OF ACTUARIAL INFORMATION:** The Workers Compensation Bureau, together with its Actuary, Glenn Evans of Pacific Actuarial Consultants, has reviewed the legislation proposed in this bill in conformance with Section 54-03-25 of the North Dakota Century Code.

Streamlines the decision-making process to allow quicker adjudication of claims and notices of decision. Clarifies the procedure for an injured worker to follow when disputing a claims decision.

ISCAL IMPACT: Not quantifiable. Will serve to reduce litigation and improve operational effectiveness and efficiency.

**AMENDMENT:** The proposed amendment allows the Bureau to issue a notice of decision, instead of a legal order, reversing a previous decision in some instances. Will serve to increase timeliness in issuing decisions.

No significant impact is anticipated.
